Teacher of the Year for the Veterans of Foreign Wars




Ms. Sullivan has been awarded Teacher of the Year for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Leon County Post 3308. Her name was advanced to the next level, and she won in District 2 of Florida. The VFW presented Ms. Sullivan with a beautiful plaque and certificate at a ceremony on April 22nd. Her nomination has now gone to the state level for further consideration. She is honored to be recognized for her dedication to teaching American history and patriotic values.

Then a surprise was bestowed upon Ms. Sullivan on May 9th, when the VFW presented her with a very unique United States flag. This flag was flown during a high-risk airdrop mission in Syria last month in an MC-130H "Combat Talon II" combat sortie by the 15th Expeditionary Special Operations Squadron. This gift was a special request from the Leon County VFW Post, and although it is rare to assign recipients to specific flags ahead of time, the soldiers on this mission knew the flag was in honor of Ms. Sullivan for winning Teacher of the Year.

Ms. Sullivan is humbled by the recognition, and plans to expand on our school's social studies programs even more next year. We are very proud of her, and look forward to seeing our veterans return for educational outreach next November.



K-4 concert - Wednesday, May 17th from 6-7pm.


5th-7th grade concert - Thursday, May 18th from 6-7pm.

In Tough Times, Keep Praise Genuine

Praising children can boost their self-esteem and keep them working when they are having a rough time with schoolwork. But sometimes, especially if they are struggling, it's hard to find something to compliment. Children always know if you're lying. So, if you are looking for a way to praise your child when things aren't going well, try to focus on something he did right. You might use a phrase such as, "That was a good try," or "The assignment is tough, but you've handled other challenges and I know you can do it." If your child continues to struggle, let the teacher know.


